However, I'd like to hear more from the downtown business community. I was hoping to meet with the two of you sometime in the next two weeks. I can meet anytime and should only need an hour, at the most. I would like to explore the follow questions:

- How do downtown business owners currently view preservation? Is it negative, positive or neutral?
- How do the Historic District Design Standards and Guidelines impact business owners?
- How can the preservation plan support the Main St. initiatives?
- How can preservation be an economic driver?"

<u>Strategy: Foster an attractive, safe, and clean environment that attracts people downtown</u> **Objective: Increase Property Investment and Reinvestment:**

- Storefront Star --- moved to 2020
- Main Street Accreditation: Dana submitted the Checklist to the Main Street consultant. Pending her feedback.

Increase interest in and in the amount of public art downtown:

- **Mural:** we missed this! The mural is now in Anchorage.
- Rain Paint: Downtown currently has two Rain Paint installations. Three more installations happening soon! One in Russian, Tagalog, and Norse.

Reduce Crime Downtown:

- Security Cameras: Mark Luchini to provide information at the Annual Meeting.
- **Security Co-Op:** Survey distributed to members. JEDC making a recommendation to the Board.
- Information-Sharing with JPD: Invited JPD and Officer Colon to the Annual Meeting.
 Officer Colon can give an announcement about his Crime Prevention through Design service.

Light up Downtown through winter

- Winter Windows: Reached out to AEYC to see if they wanted to do another collaboration this year. Completed in 2017 through a collaboration with AEYC and JEDC.
- **Design winter light plan**: Infrastructure committee members put a bug in the ear of some property owners. On the next Infrastructure Committee agenda.

Strategy: Improve Access to, from, and within Downtown

Objective: Promote transportation other than single-passenger vehicles

- Promote Bus Usage: Inviting Capital Transit to the Annual Meeting.
- Parking: Parking video in the works. Concept and videographers outlined.
- **Bike Access:** hasn't been worked on yet.

Increase ease of walking downtown

- Branded umbrellas: Dana to come up with a system for the next Legislative Session.
- **Continue to improve DBA Map & Guidebook**: we can incorporate feedback from this year into next year's map.
- Parklet Day: Dana and Chris Mertl to come up with a parklet space idea!
- Inform members of their sidewalk responsibilities: We can include this in the Annual Meeting! In member packets but we can include in the next newsletter.
- Wayfinding Did walk audit and identified spots for the signs. Dana and Nathaniel to talk to Ed Foster. Next meeting on July 15th



Strategy: Downtown is a Family-Friendly Destination year round

Objective: Program Quarterly Family-Friendly Events

- **Gallery Walk:** Continue to engage members and improve.
- **Neighbors Day at Capital Park:** One down. Need to plan another one. We had planned for one in April but time got away from us.
- Free parking for winter shoppers: we wrote a letter to the City Manager about free parking but we should write the letter again and submit sooner for 2018 shopping season.
- Create a signature DBA Fundraiser Maybe Cornhole can be that? Or Color Run?
- **Bike event:** DBA participated in Bike to Work Day. The Bike to Work Day event was successful in Dana's opinion considering it was the first year DBA had a station.
- Collaboration with Community Partners: How can we collaborate more with JAHC for First Friday?
- Plan and Host a Downtown Fun Run Fundraiser: Done and successful!
- **Downtown Restaurant Week:** Done and successful. DBA Board decided to do it once a year.
- **First Friday:** There's room for growth here. Discussion to be included in the marketing committee.
- **Continue Downtown Deals inserts:** Done. The DBA Board has decided to do it twice a year.
- Downtown Marketing: Marketing Downtown like a Tour/make commercial/video: an overall marketing strategy needs to be made. I started working on one.
- Be a part of DIG Cleanup Day or Litter Free: Didn't happen. Move to 2019.
- Downtown Swagger: Didn't happen. Move to 2019.

Reach out to organizations with a youth focus to hold events downtown

- Local organizations: Need to still make a list of relevant organizations and invite them to host events downtown. Already reached out to Girl Scouts to have them baby sit during Gallery Walk.
- National outreach: Kid list has been designed into a brochure. Drew Green will
 distribute to all the ships once it's completed.
